

DRAWING EXERCISE 3 - Part 2 - DESIGN & COLOUR




STEP 1

FROM YOUR FIVE WONKY LINE DRAWINGS, CHOOSE THE ONE YOU LIKE THE MOST...




STEP 2

PLACE A PIECE OF A4 TRACING PAPER OVER THE DRAWING AND SECURE IT TO THE WORK SURFACE WITH SOME TAPE.



STEP 3

USING A FINELINER PEN WITH THE HAND YOU
USUALLY DRAW AND WRITE WITH, TRACE OVER
YOUR WONKY DRAWN LINES, AS FAITHFULLY AS
POSSIBLE, RESISTING THE URGE TO 'CORRECT' THE
DRAWING.



STEP 4


NEXT, PLACE THE TRACED DRAWING ON THE TRACING PAPER ONTO AN A3 SHEET OF DRAWING PAPER, AT AN INTERESTING ANGLE OR POSITION.



STEP 5

SECURE THE TRACED DRAWING IN POSITION WITH SOME MASKING TAPE AND INSERT YOUR SHEET OF TRANSFER PAPER IN BETWEEN.

WITH A BALLPOINT PEN, TRACE OVER THE LINES AGAIN TO TRANSFER THE DRAWING IN PLACE...



STEP 6

NEXT, RE-POSITION THE TRACING OVER THE TRANSFERRED DRAWING SO THAT THE SHAPES OVERLAP AND INTERSECT...




STEP 7

...AGAIN, TRANSFER THE DRAWING BY TRACING OVER THE LINEWORK AGAIN...




STEP 8

STEP 9


...CONTINUE UNTIL YOU FEEL YOU HAVE AN INTERESTING AND UNIQUE DESIGN.



STEP 10

WHEN YOU ARE SATISFIED WITH THE LINE WORK, BEGIN TO APPLY SOME GOOD COMPLIMENTARY COLOURS, CHOOSING A DIFFERENT COLOUR FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL SHAPE CREATED BY THE OVERLAPPING DRAWINGS.
